- \cdot A documented test sailing in which the person is starting in a race included in the Swedish Cup gives 10 points
- · (The Punch Cup is not included in the competition)

When do we start and when do we stop?

The draft starts when the presentation is presented on the Finn associations website and runs until the end of the Swedish championships 2020.

What are you winning?

All Finn sailors will win because the competition probably leads us to become more people who sail
