

Invitation to the Scandinavian Finn Cup 2026

For the first time, the Scandinavian Finn Cup will be held – a new collaboration between the Swedish, Norwegian, and Danish Finn Class Associations. By taking part in two of the Nordic region's most attractive regattas, you automatically compete for the inaugural Scandinavian Finn Cup title.

Included Regattas

- International Norwegian Championships, Larvik (13–16 August)
- Open Swedish Finn Class Championship & Danish Championship in FINN, Varberg (21–23 August)

The Swedish and Danish Championships will be sailed as a joint regatta in Varberg. National champions will be crowned among each country's sailors, but on the water everyone competes together – ensuring large, competitive, and exciting fleets.

Travel to Larvik and onward to Varberg

From Sweden and Finland: Take the Moss–Horten ferry, followed by a short drive to Larvik. From Denmark and continental Europe: Take the Hirtshals–Larvik ferry, with the yacht club located just a few hundred meters from the terminal.

After the racing in Larvik: Take the Sandefjord–Strömstad ferry (approx. 30 km from Larvik), then enjoy a smooth drive south to Varberg. Discounted ferry packages for Finn sailors may become available.

Prizes and Cup Results

A separate prize list for the Scandinavian Finn Cup will be published ahead of the season. The associations and our sponsors will contribute attractive prizes for the top performers.

Sail both regattas – or choose one

You are warmly welcome to sail both events and thereby participate in the Cup, but you may of course also choose to enter only one of the regattas.

Welcome to two weeks of sailing, camaraderie, and Scandinavian summer. Take the opportunity to experience some of the best sailing waters in the Nordic region, meet friends old and new, and be part of the very first edition of the Scandinavian Finn Cup.
